



Your Child's Personal Daycare Set

To create a calm, organised environment and maintain the highest standards of hygiene, each child is provided with their own personalised set of items for use at daycare.

Each learner is assigned a unique animal and colour combination upon enrolment. This system helps children easily identify their belongings, promotes independence, and assists with organisation throughout the day.

Examples include:

-  Lion – Pink
-  Elephant – Blue
-  Tiger – Mustard Yellow
-  Hippo – Purple
-  Zebra – Red
-  Giraffe – Green

You may notice that we often refer to children by their animal names in newsletters, learning stories, displays, and internal documentation. This approach helps us protect children's privacy while still celebrating their achievements and experiences.

The following items are included as part of your child's personal daycare set:

Sleep & Rest

- Cot sheet
- Waterproof mattress protector
- Summer sleep sack
- Winter sleep sack
- Fleece blanket
- Personal towel
- Animal-themed comfort pillow
- Bedding storage bag



Personal Care & Hygiene

- 10 facecloths
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Personal toothbrush holder and rinsing cup
- Hairbrush, comb, and basic hairstyling accessories
- Personal laundry basket
- Nappy changing mat
- Potty-training equipment (Bumbo Step 'n Stack toileting set)
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Feeding & Mealtimes

- Silicone plate, bowl, cup, spoon, and bib set
- Water bottle (older infants and toddlers)
- Open drinking cups (toddlers)
- Feeding support pillow
- 10 Glodina burp cloths (infants)

Learning & Communication

- Daily communication notebook
- Personal A5 art portfolio/file
- Individual storage space for artwork and special projects

Storage & Organisation

- Personal toy basket (infants under 12 months)
- Personal nappy storage basket (infants)
- Individual labelled storage space for spare clothing and personal belongings
- Wet bag for personal items when required

Outdoor Play

- Sun hat
- Indoor slippers



Additional Items Provided by the Daycare

- Daily laundering of bedding, facecloths, towels, bibs, and daycare-used clothing
- Wet wipes for daily care
- Nappy cream (with parental consent)
- Sunscreen (with parental consent)
- Art and sensory materials
- Educational resources and learning materials

Parents are asked to ensure that all clothing brought to daycare is clearly marked with their child's name to help us keep track of jackets, jerseys, socks, hats, and spare clothing.

Our goal is to create a true home-away-from-home experience where children feel secure, cared for, and confident in their environment. By providing each child with their own personalised set of belongings, we are able to maintain excellent hygiene standards while fostering independence and a strong sense of belonging.
